



# Oregon Data extracted from the National Survey on Drug Use and Health, released December 2020

The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) provides national and state-level data on the use of tobacco, alcohol, illicit drugs (including the non-medical use of prescription drugs) and mental health in the United States. Information from NSDUH is used to support prevention and treatment programs, monitor substance use trends, estimate the need for treatment and inform public health policy.

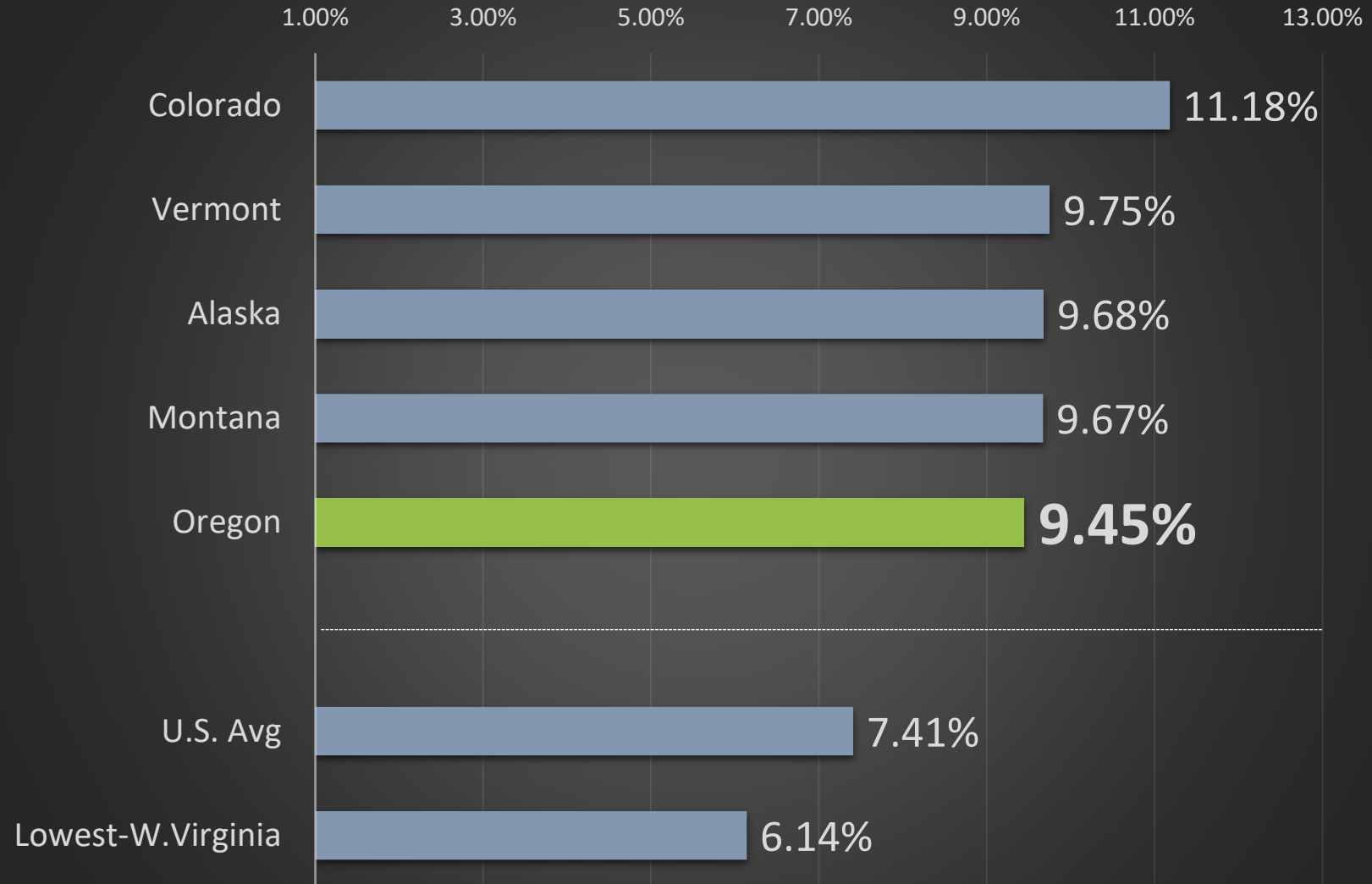

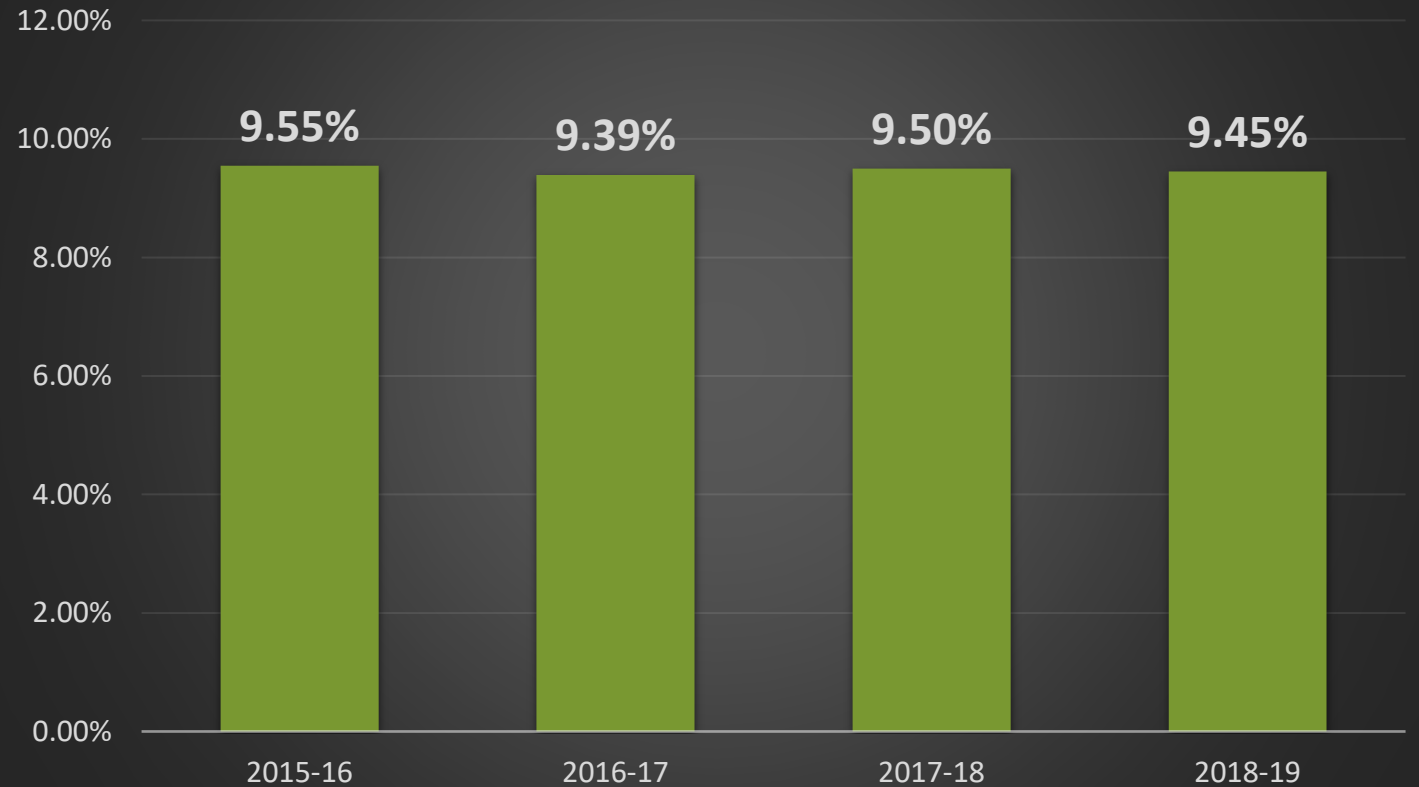

**% of Oregon population with past year SUD**





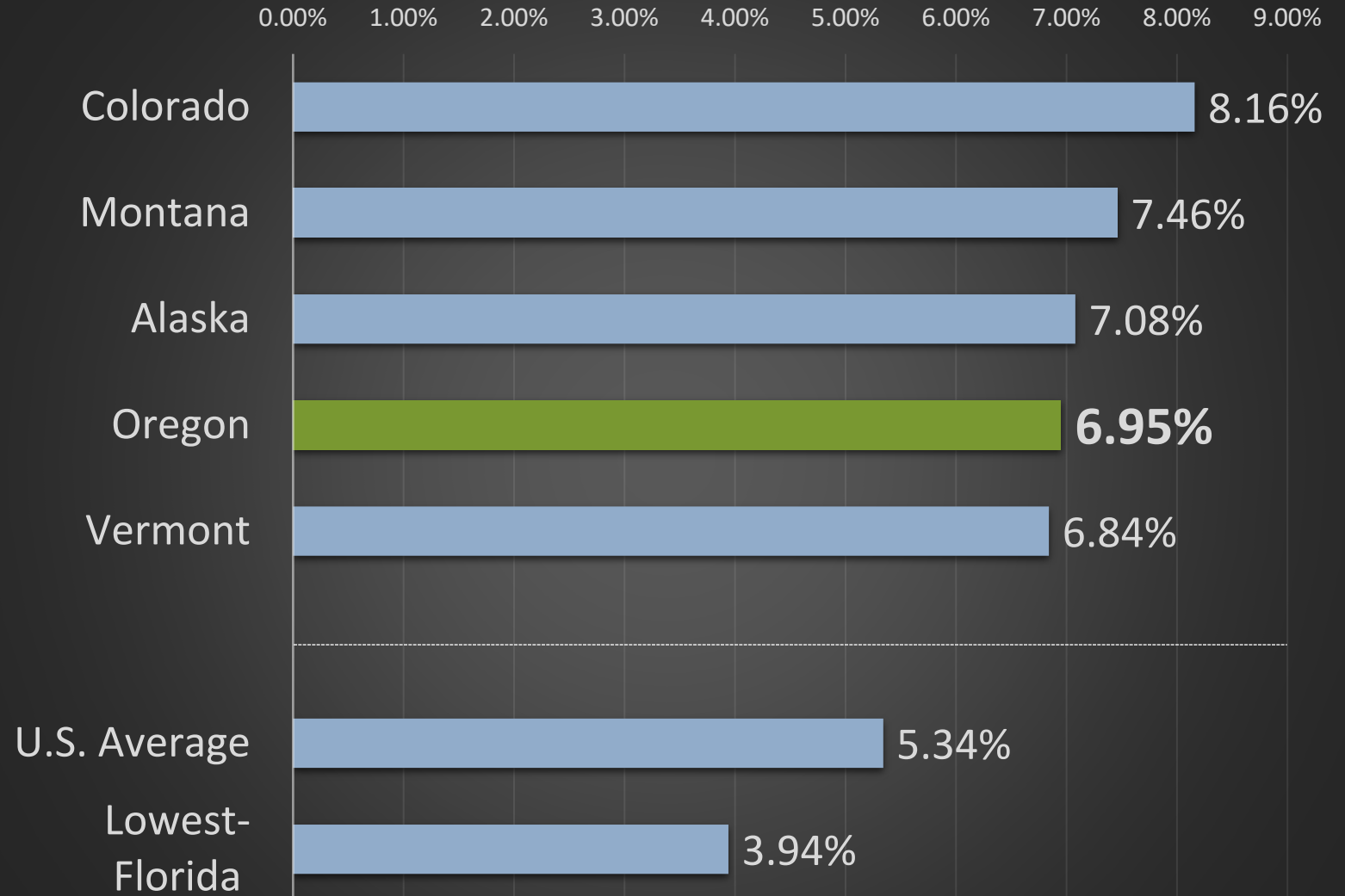

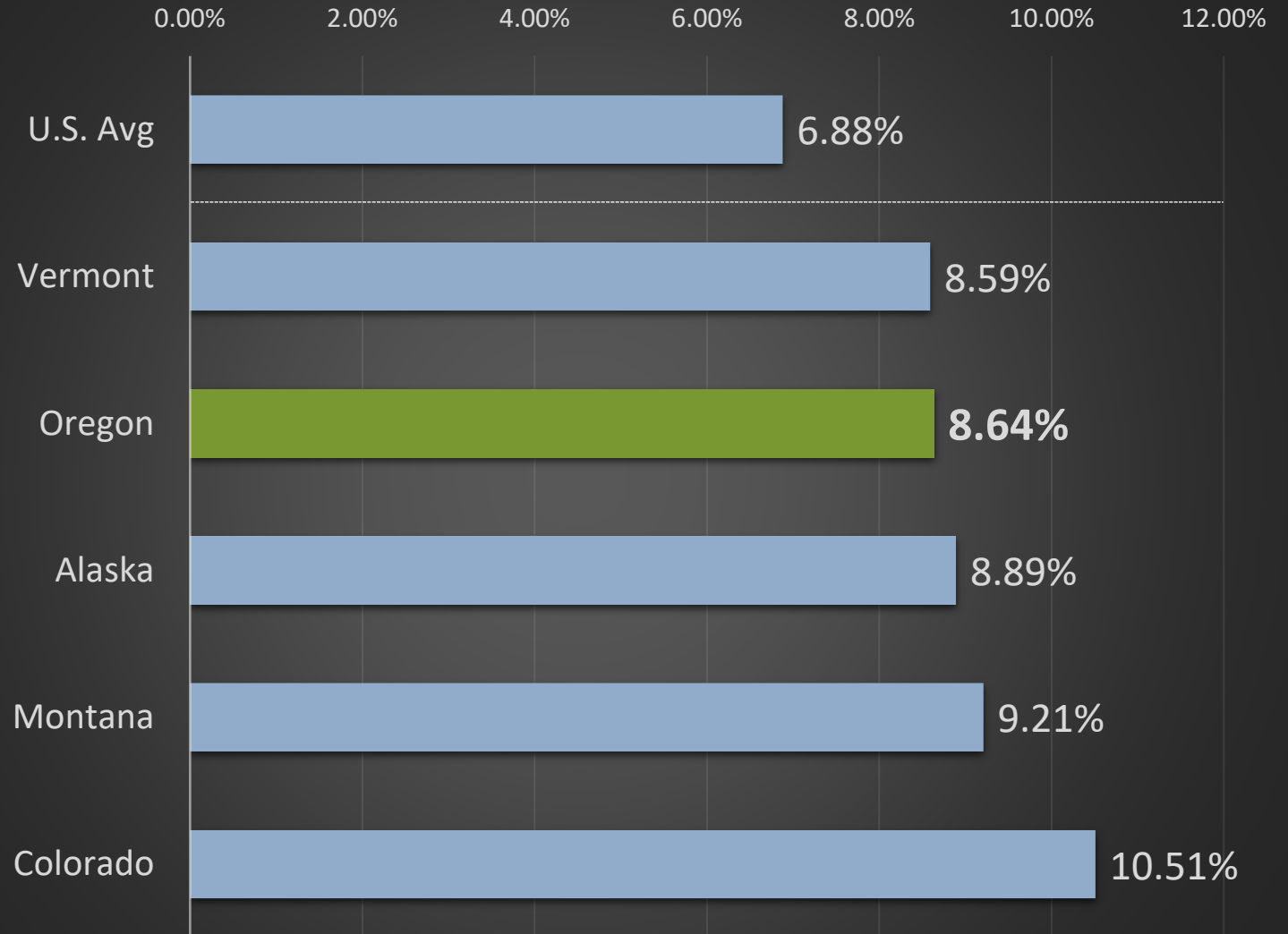

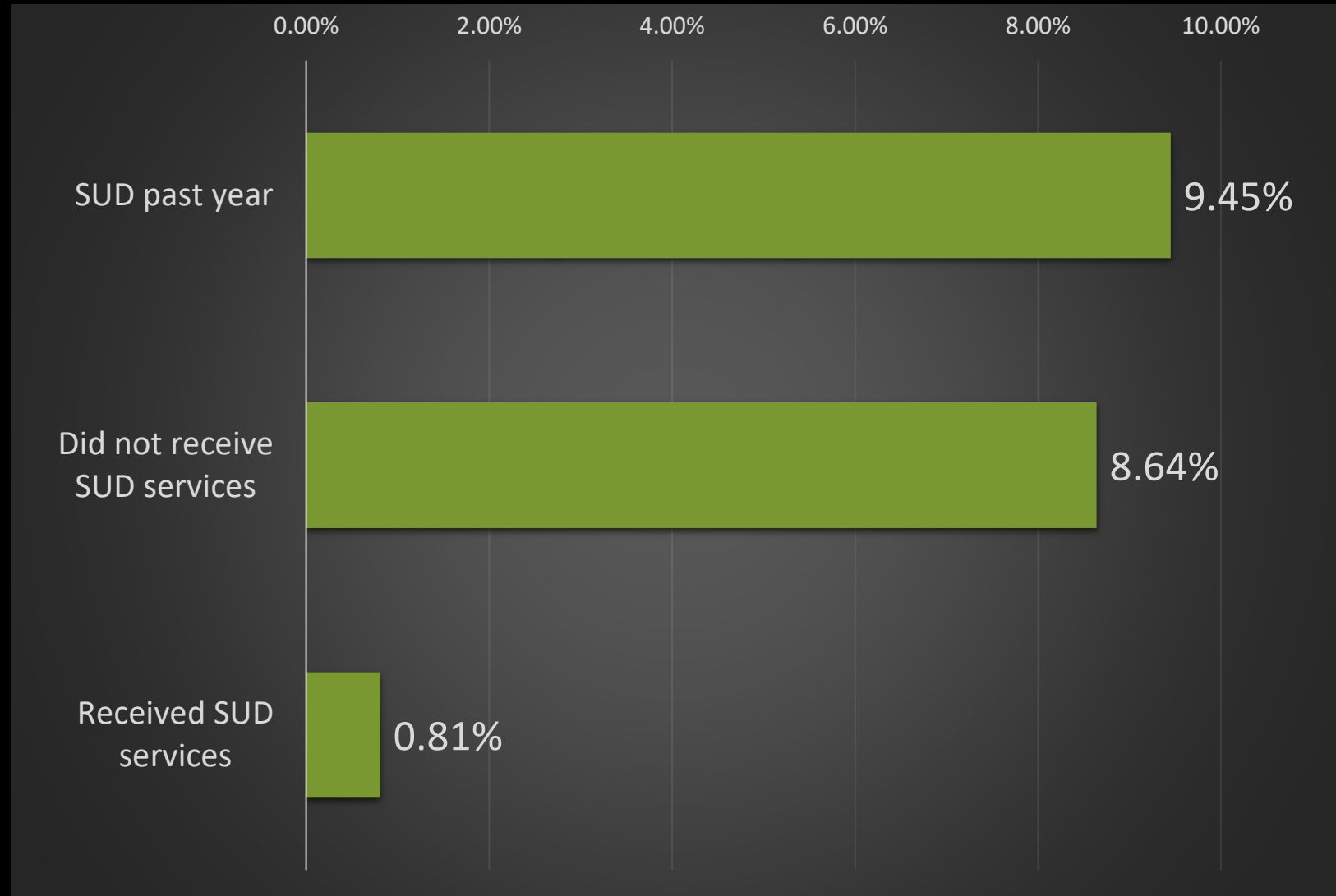

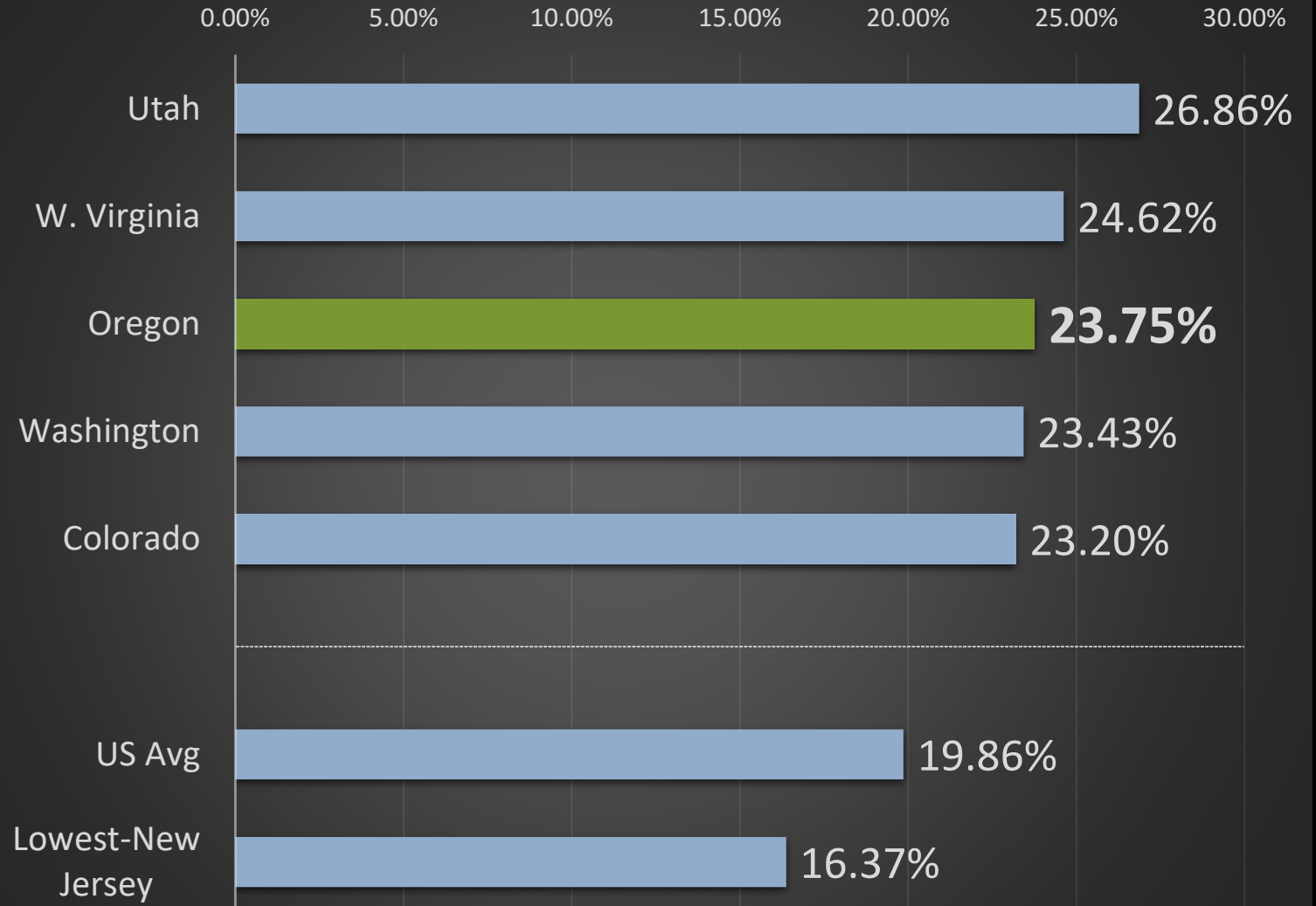

*Oregon's mental illness rate is 19.5% higher than the national average*





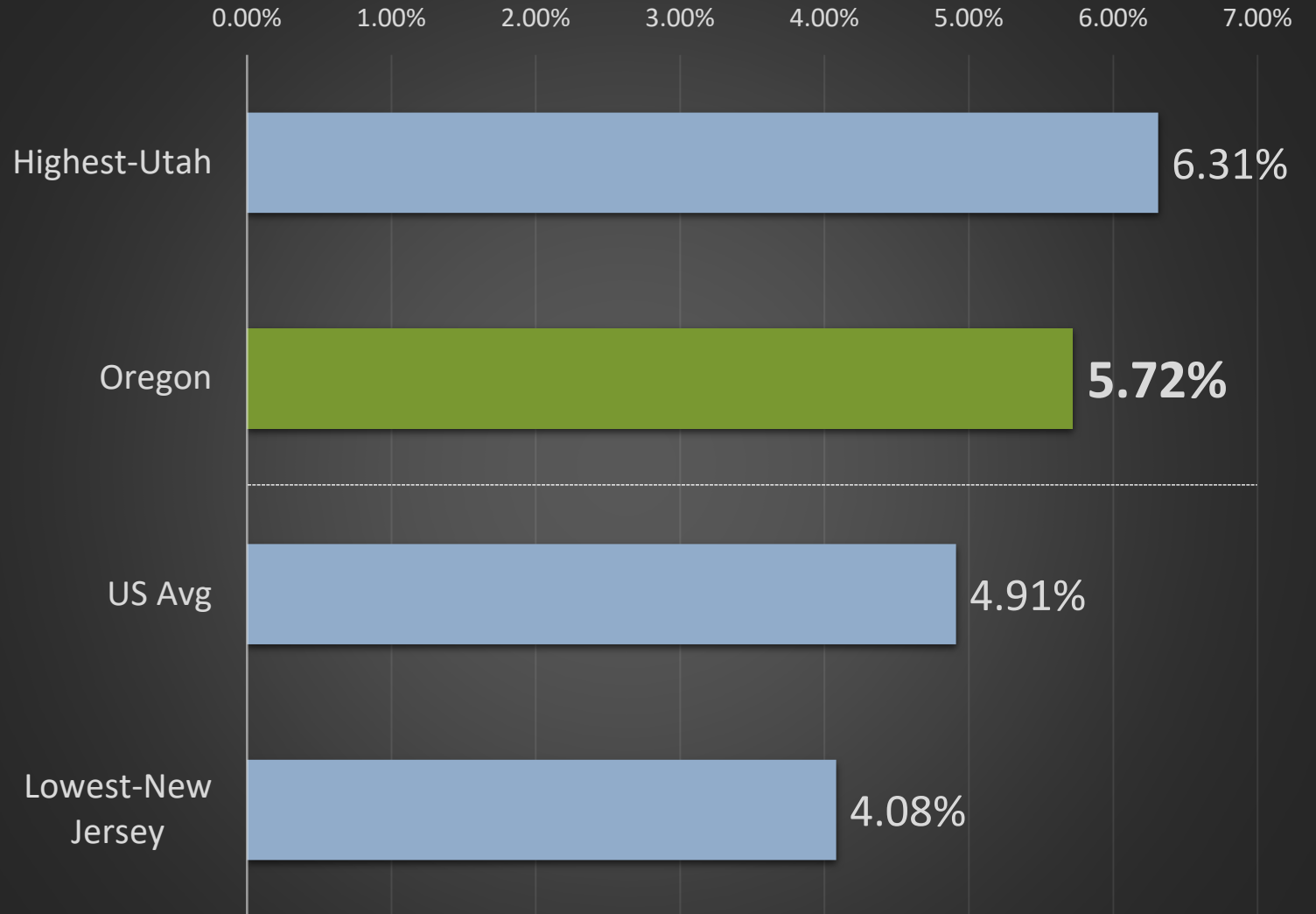

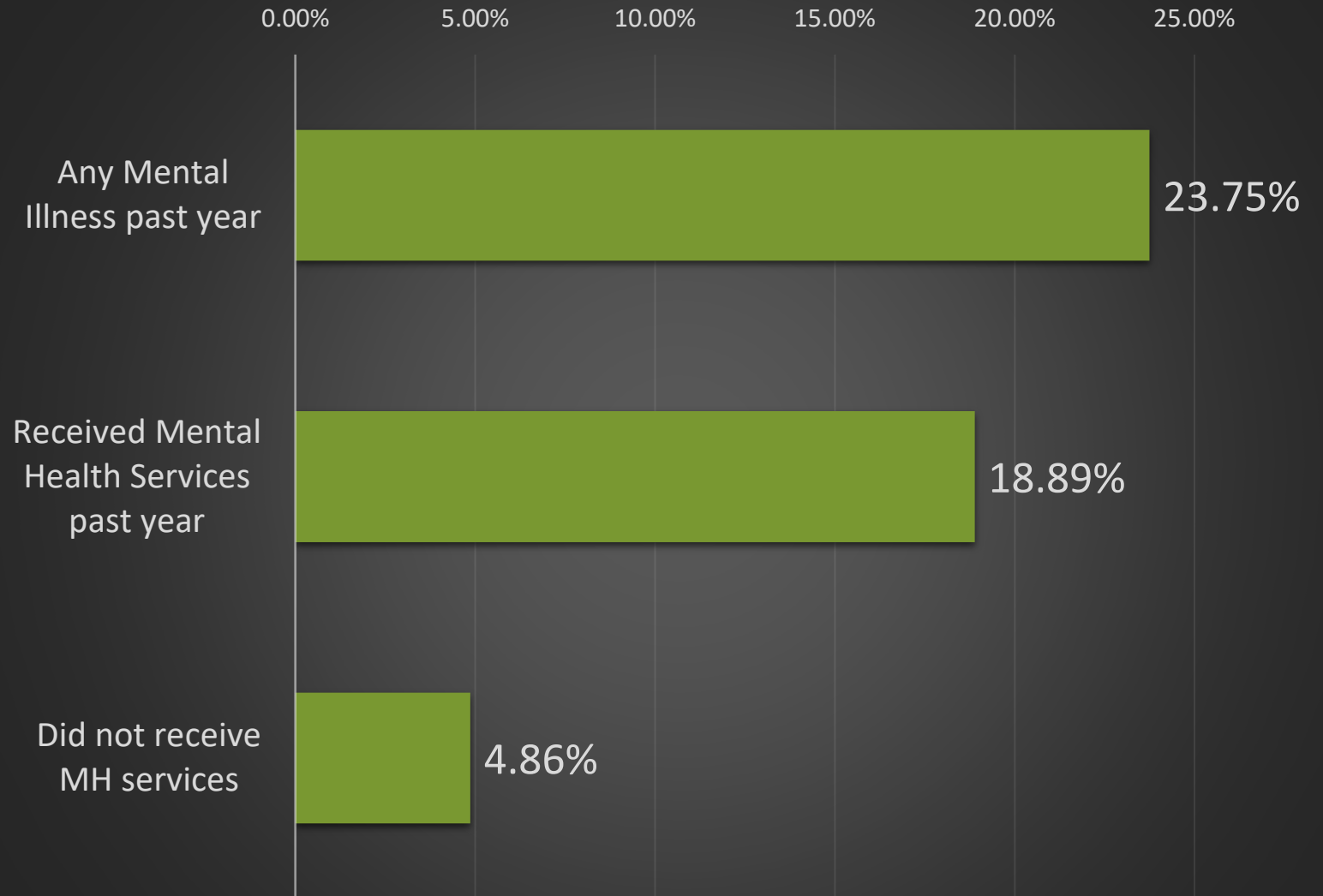

*Percent of population (teens & adults) with past year: any mental illness, and services for mental health*

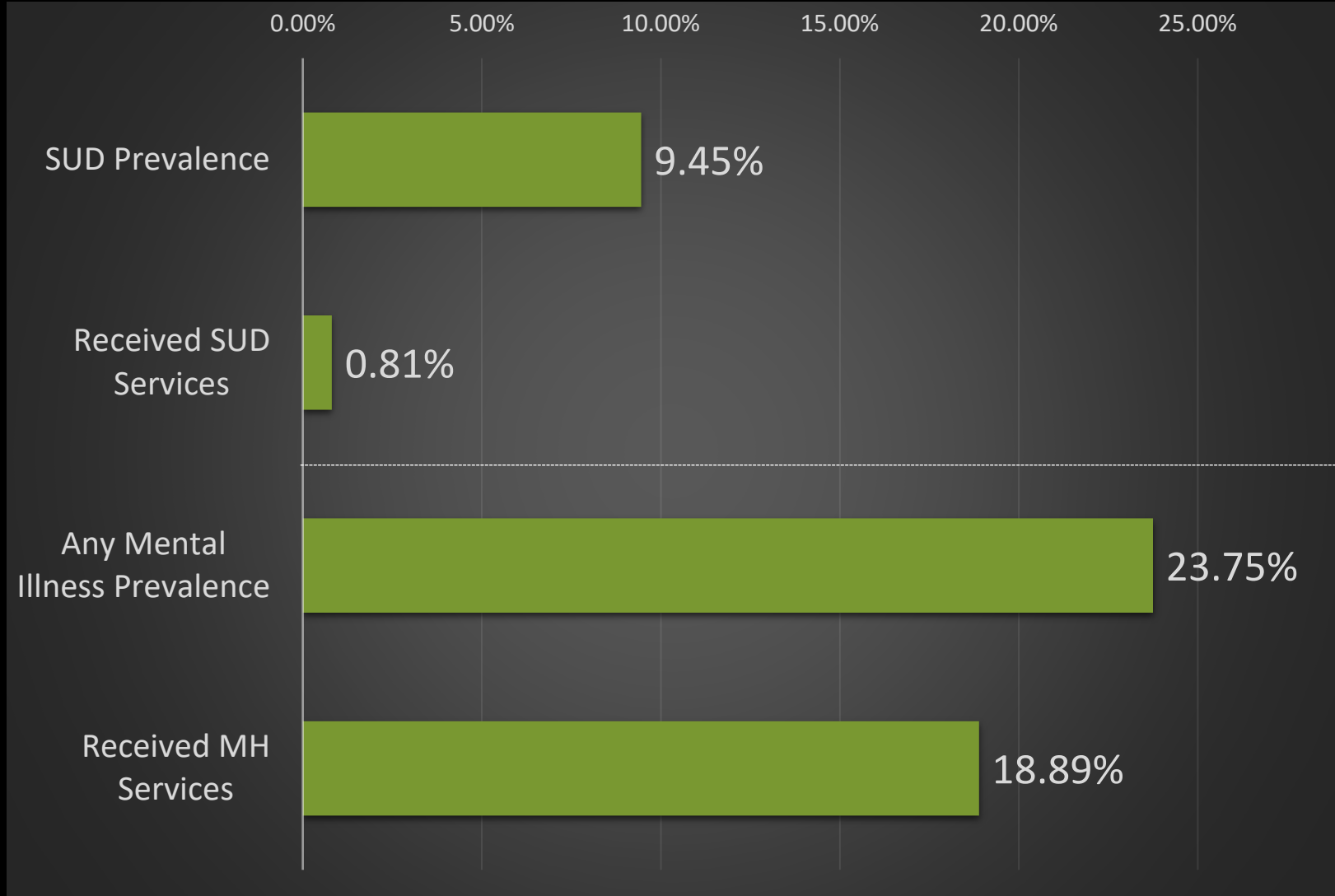




# Needing and Receiving services for SUD & Mental Health

*Percent of population (teens & adults) with past year: Needing and receiving services for SUD and mental health*





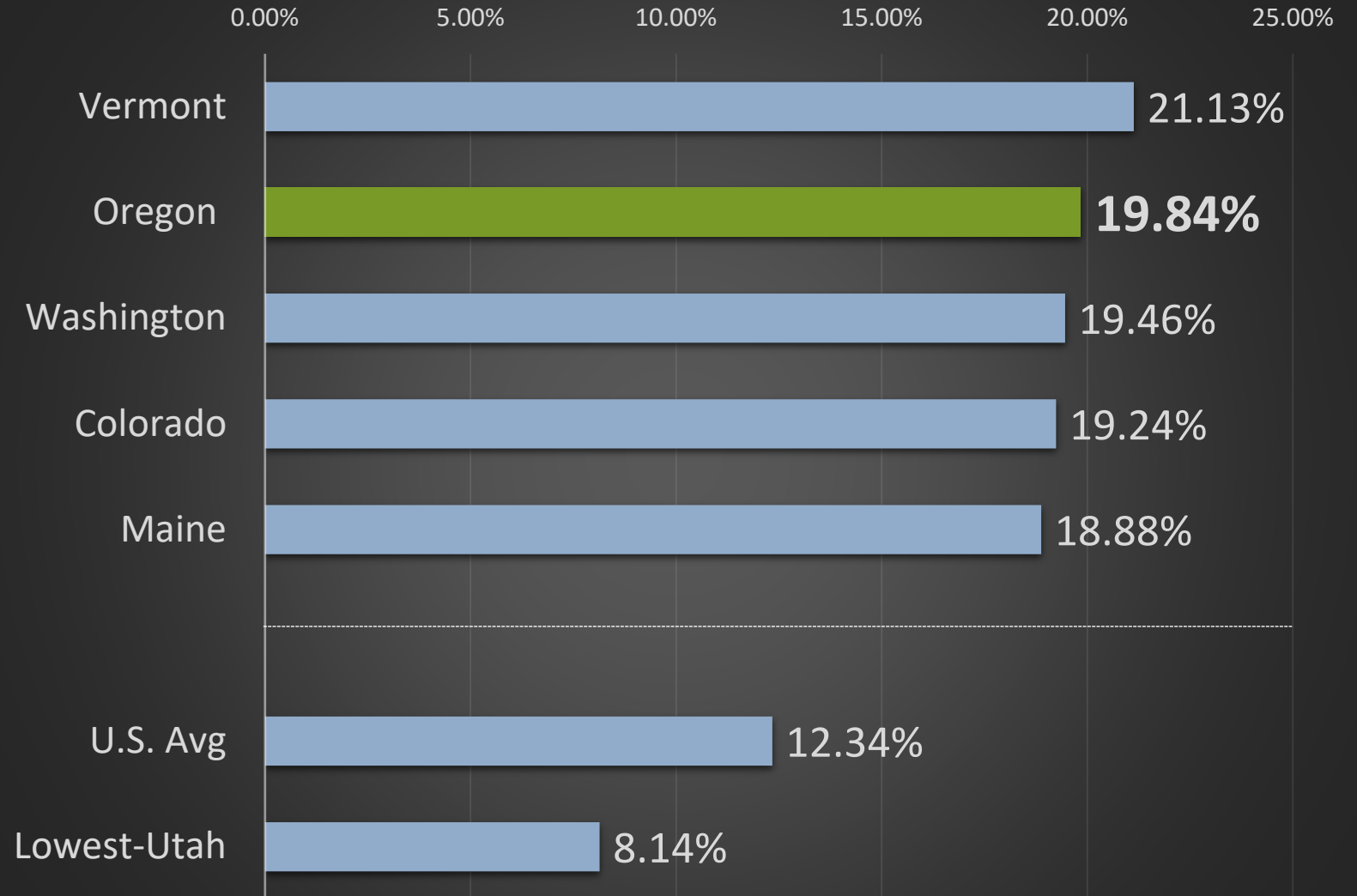
# Illicit Drug Use in the Past Month, *by Age Group and State: Percentages, NSDUH*

*Percent of population (teens & adults) reporting past month illicit drug use*





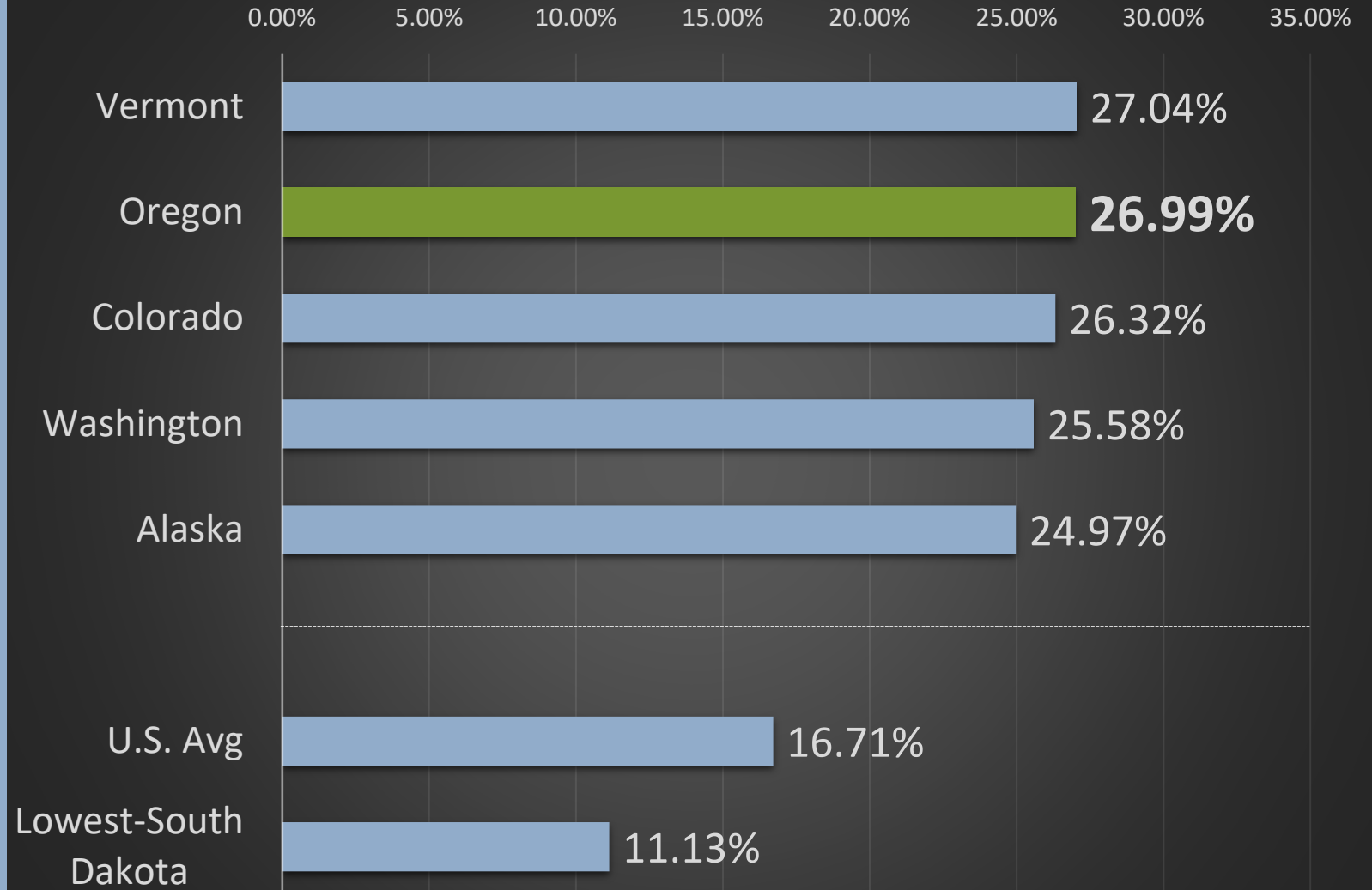

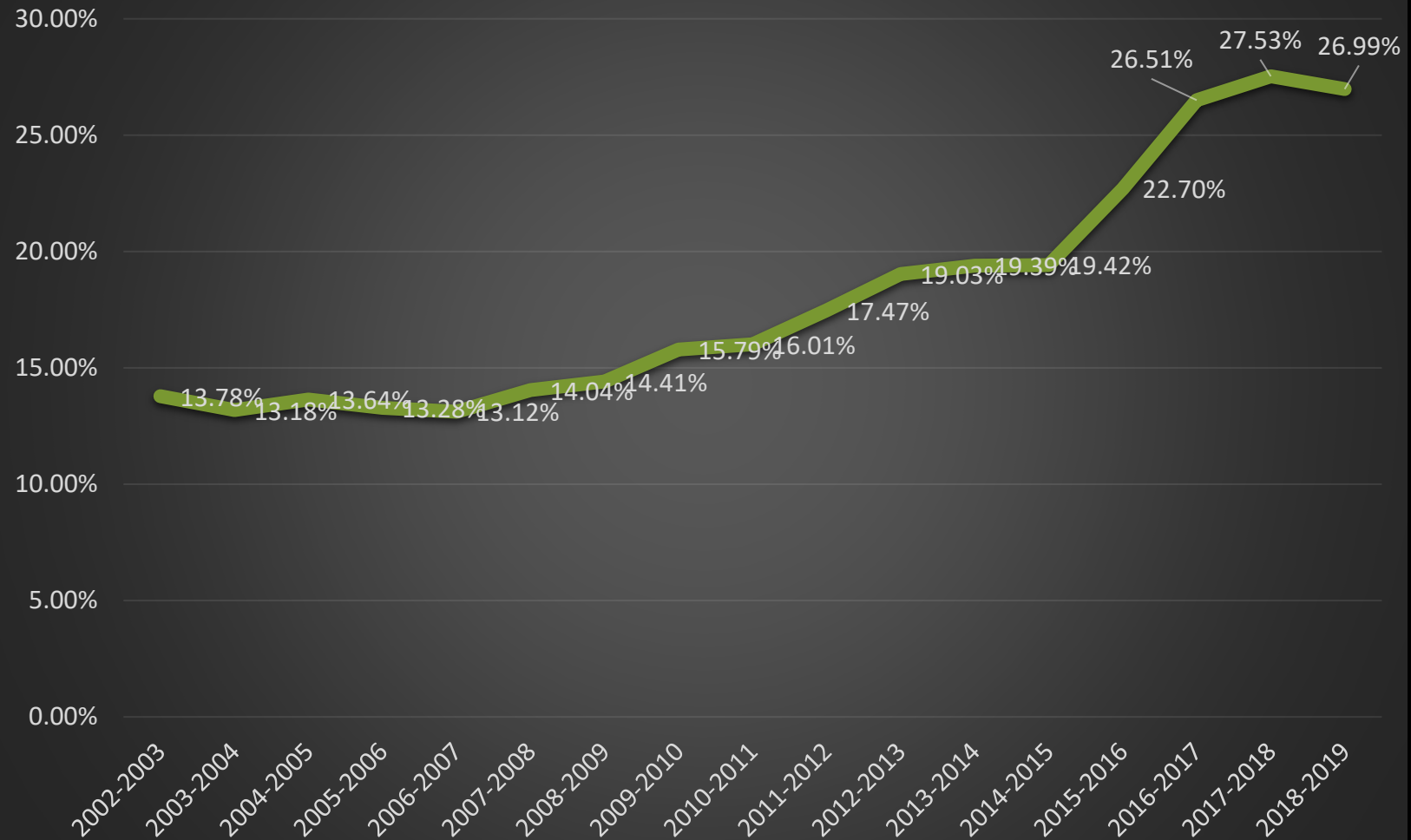

### Past Year Marijuana Use 2002-2019



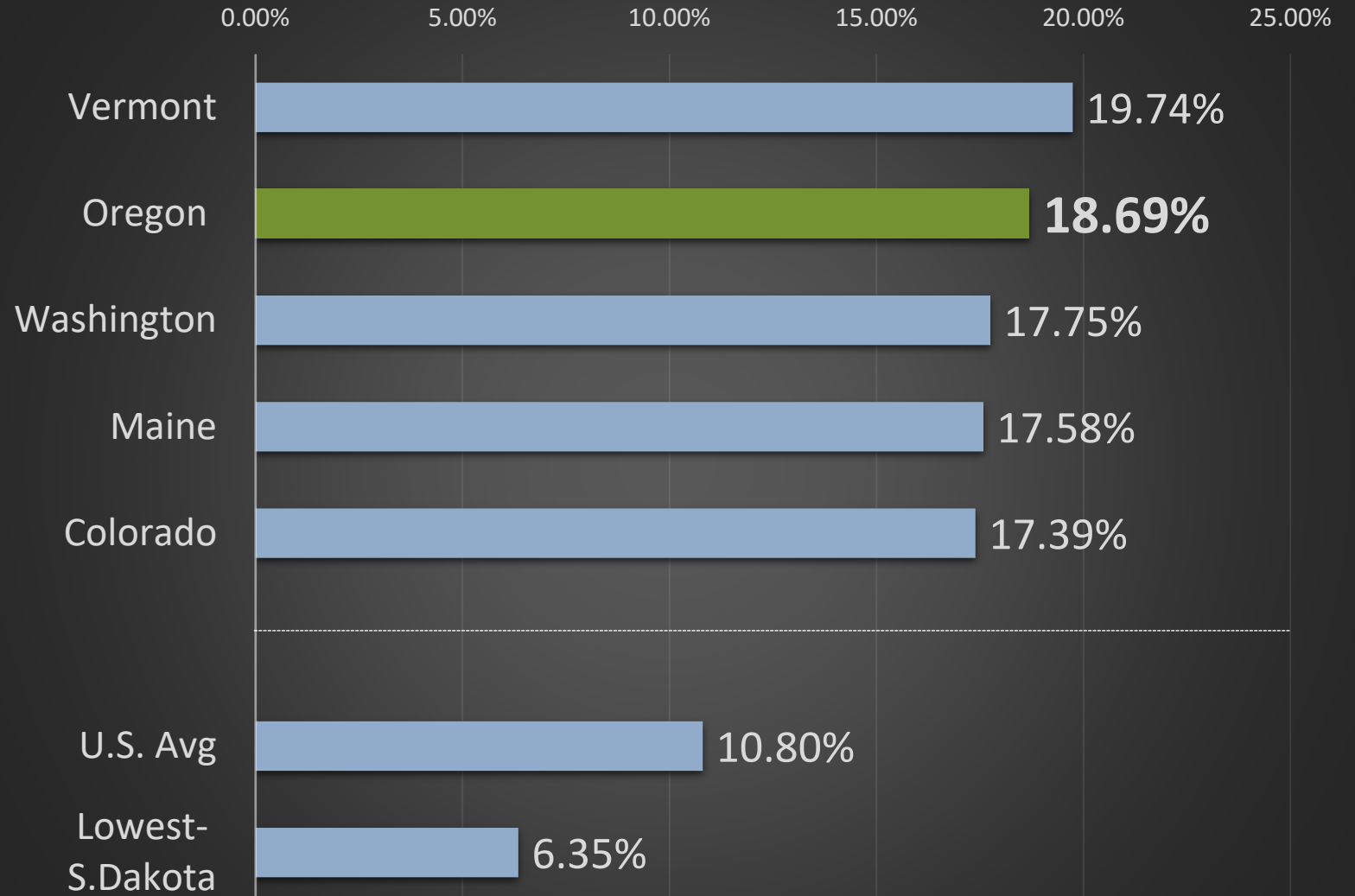

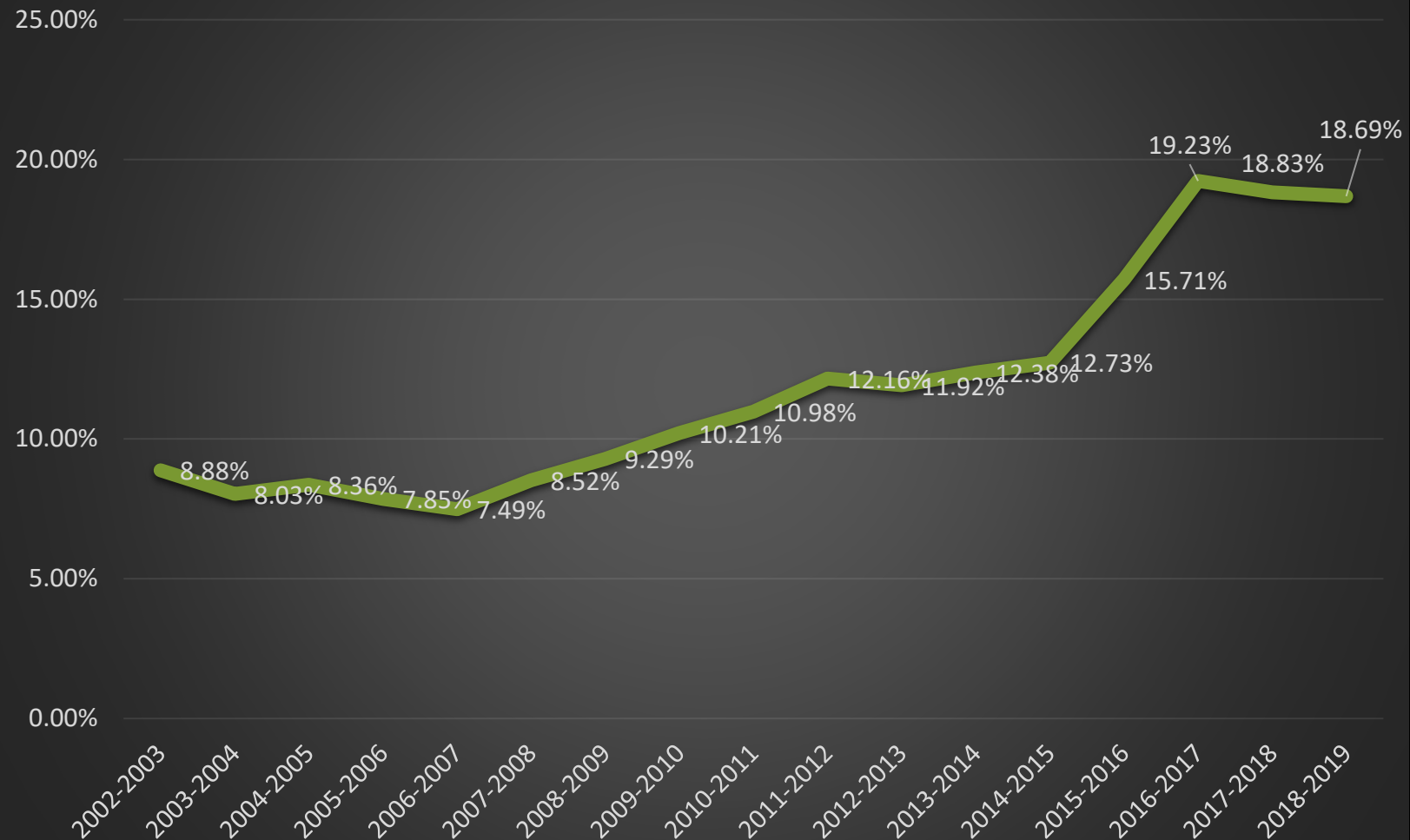

### Past Month Marijuana Use 2002-2018



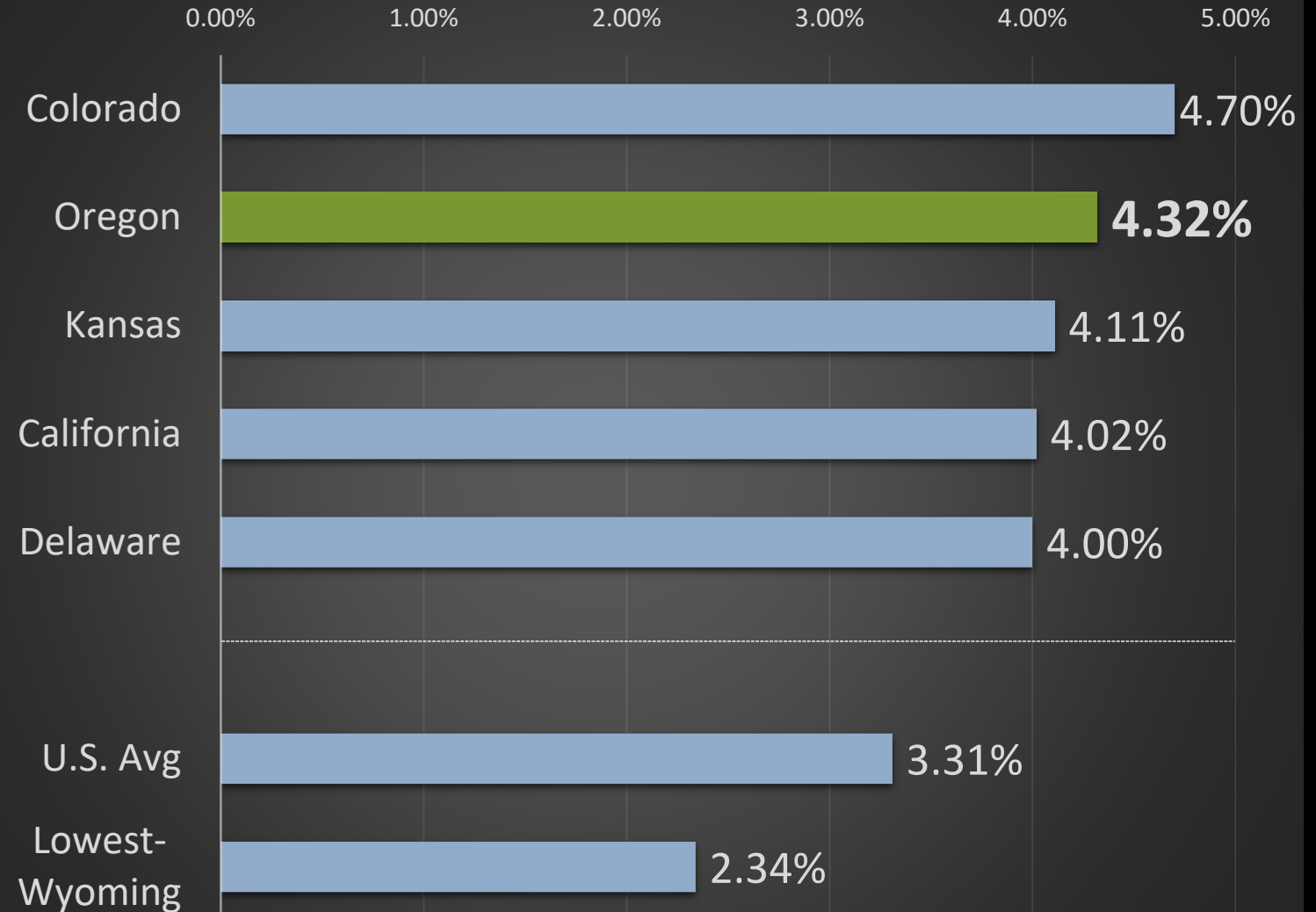

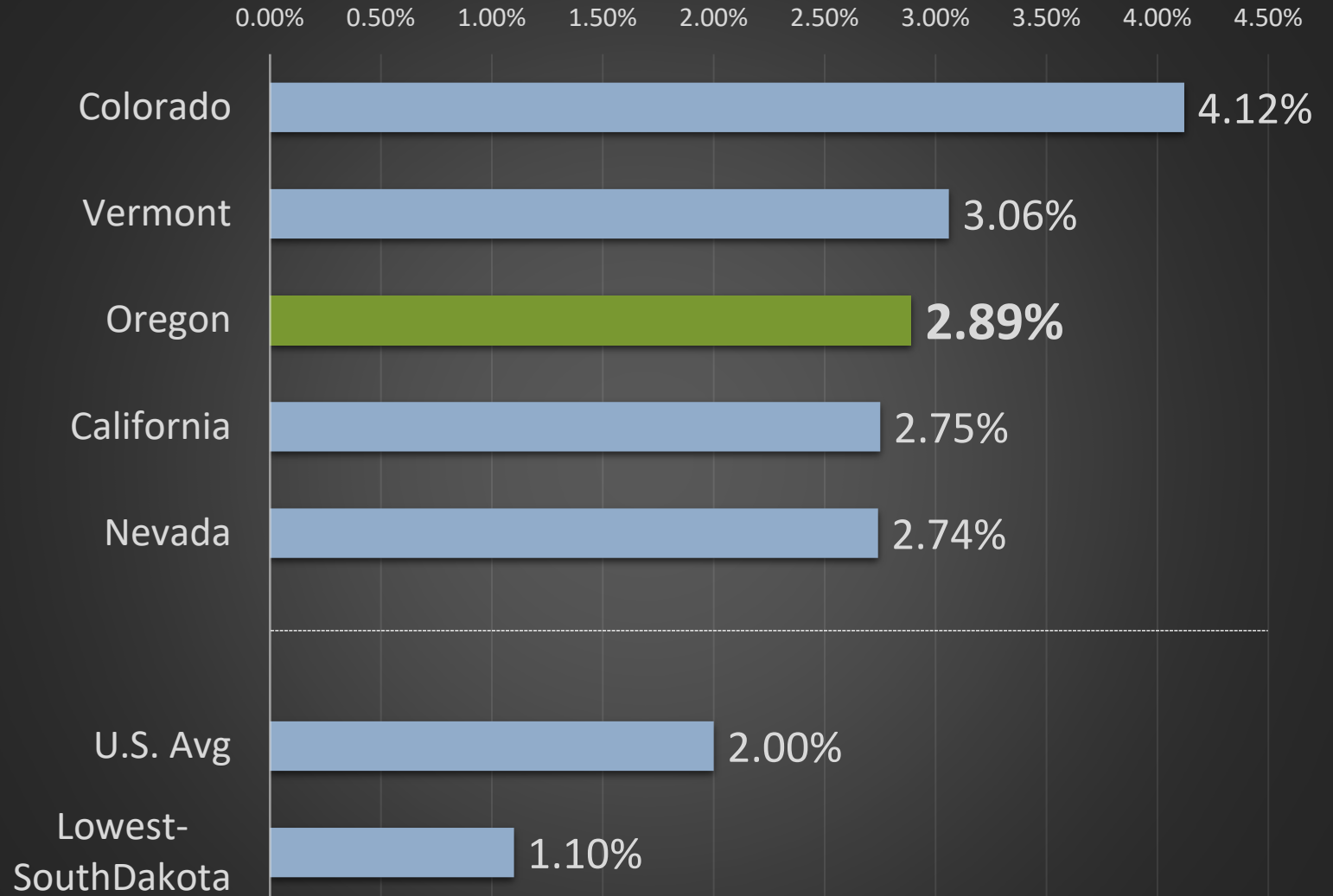
# Cocaine use Past Year, *by Age Group and State: Percentages, NSDUH December 2020*

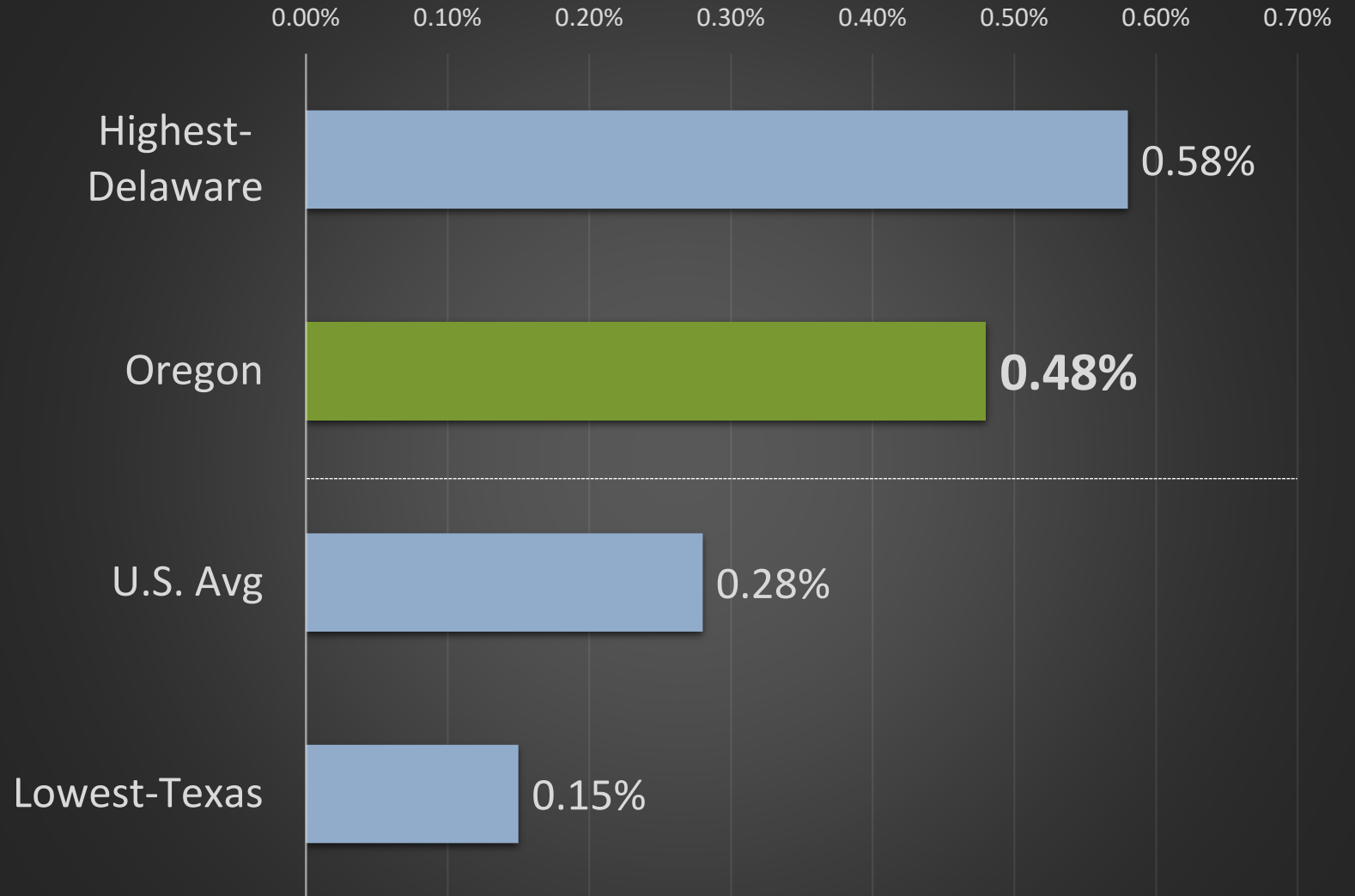

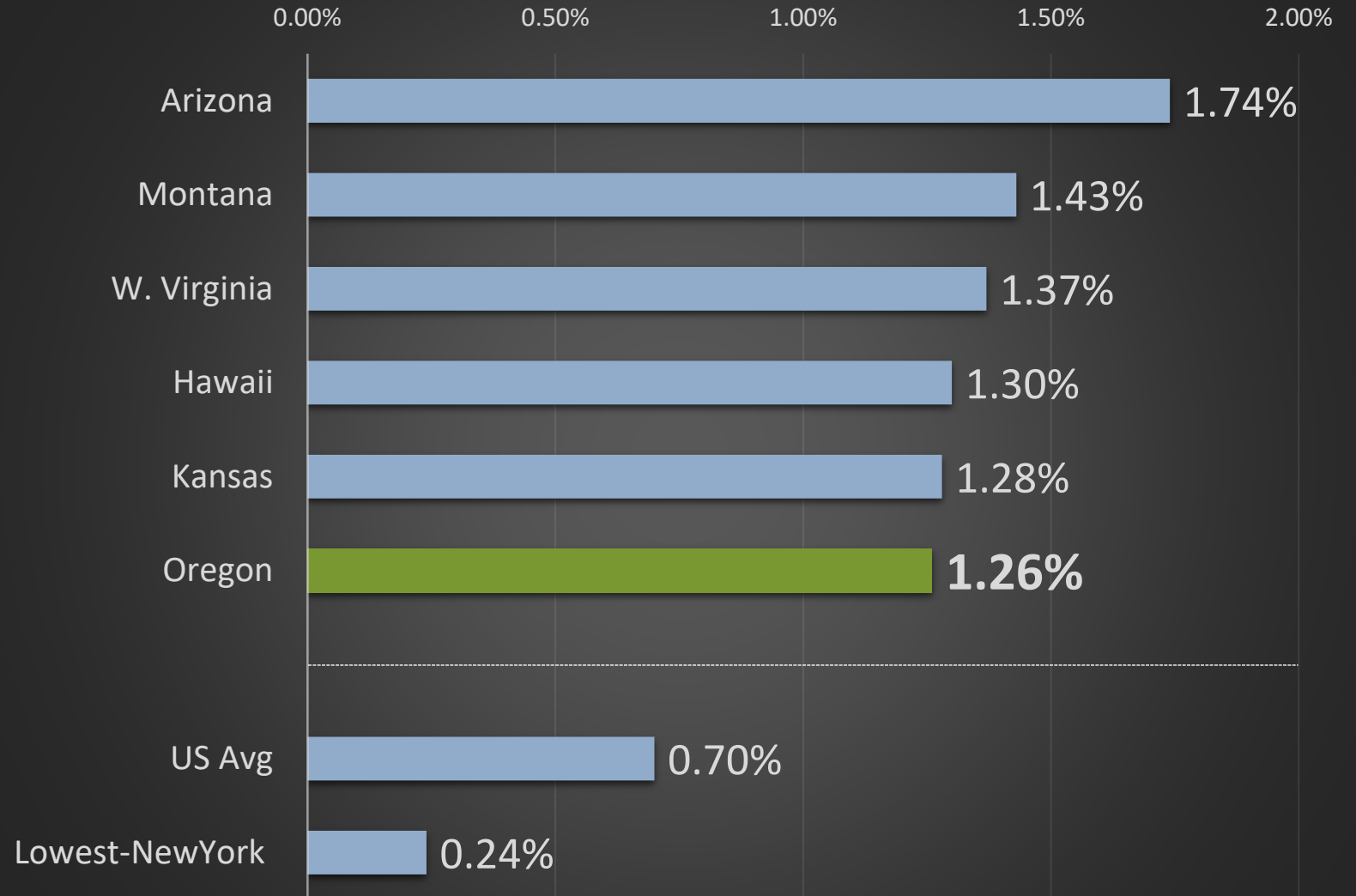
# Methamphetamine use Past Year, *by Age Group and State: Percentages, NSDUH*

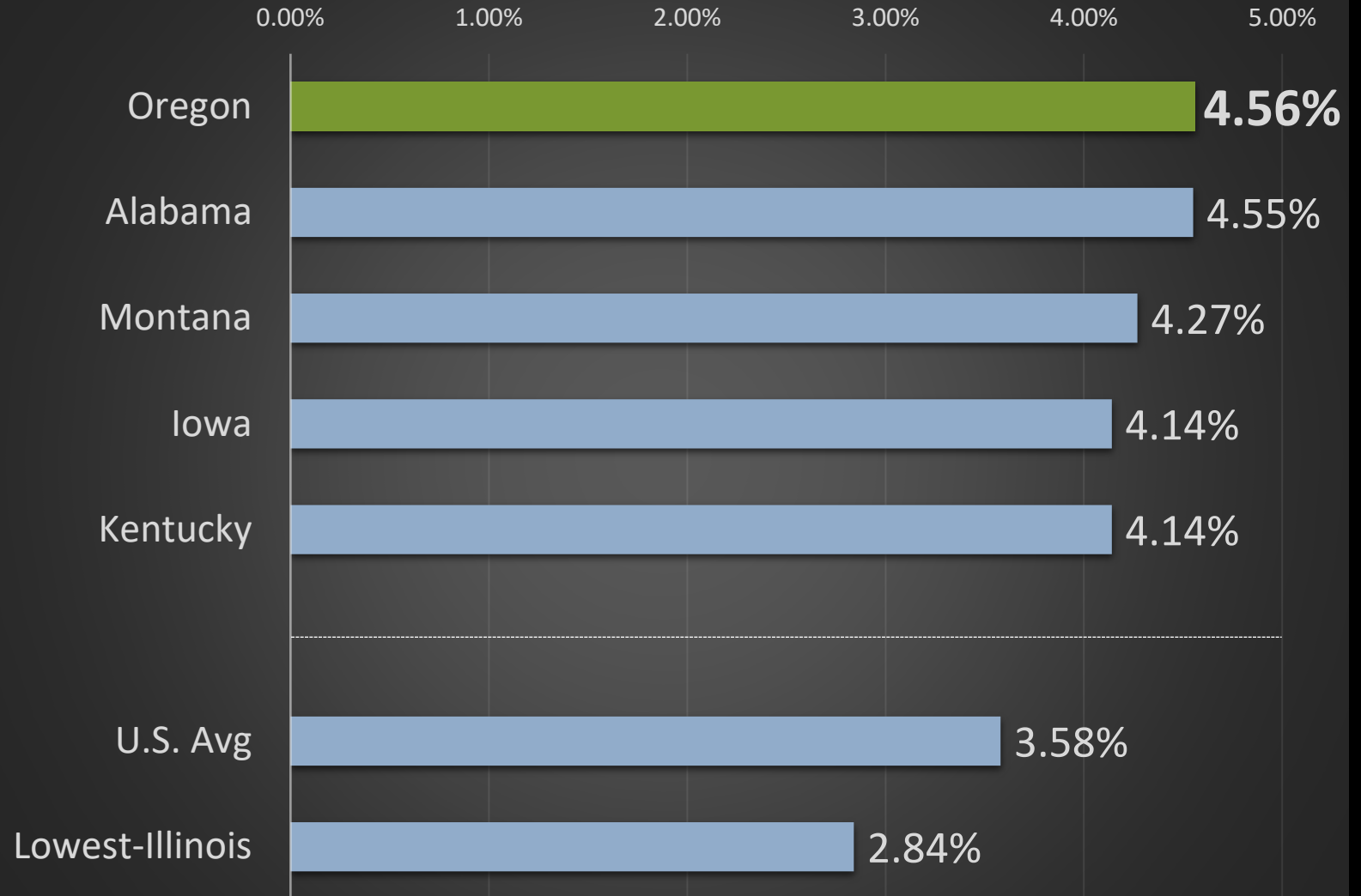

*Percent of population (teens & adults) reporting past year Rx opioid misuse*





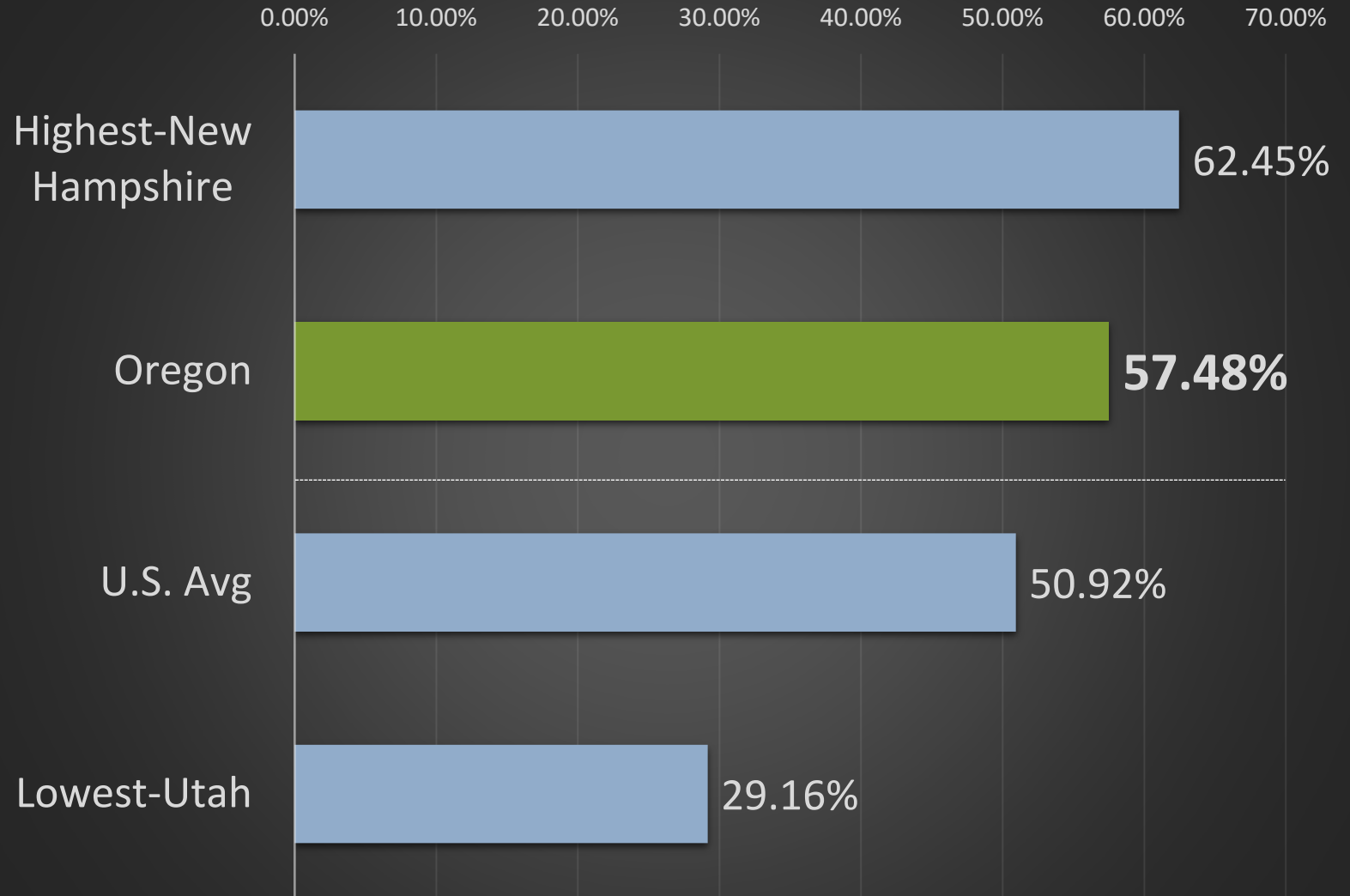
