As part of our standard administrative review of all officer-involved shootings, the Training Division and the Internal Affairs Division will now review the incident. **There is no allegation of misconduct against the involved officers.** This officer is considered to be a witness to the incident; however, all actions during the incident will be reviewed for policy violations and adherence to training guidelines. There will be a Use of Force Board review of this case in the near future, at which the involved officer(s) will also have an opportunity to present information.
